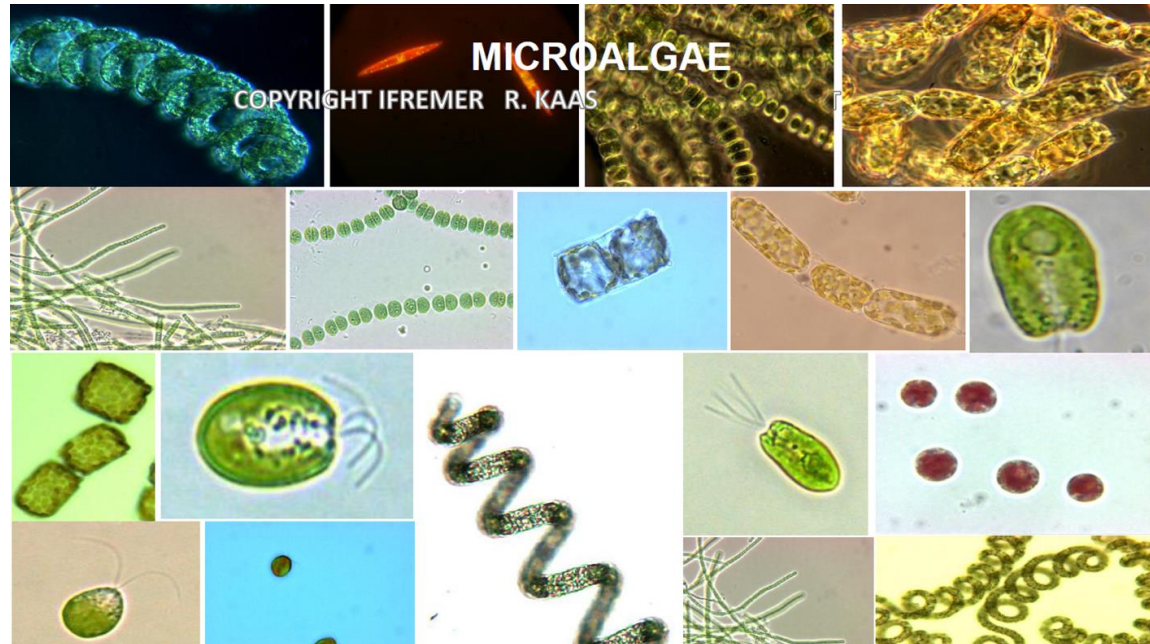


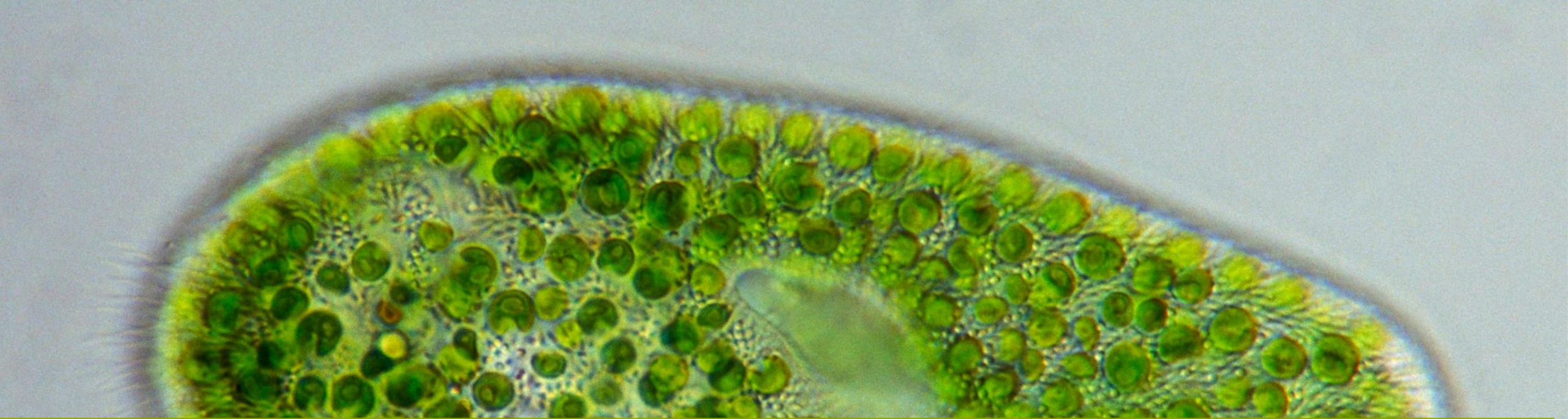

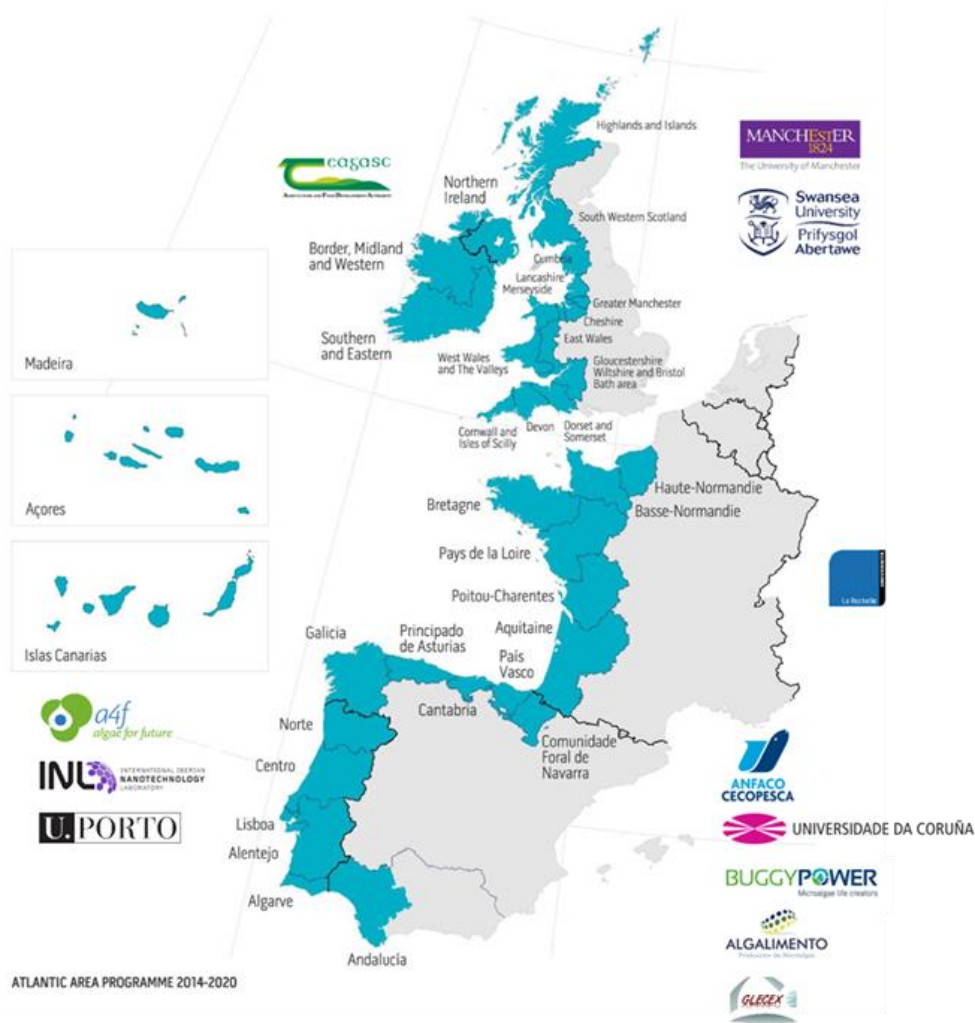

**Action 4.2. Create a database of stakeholders and other key experts of the microalgae sector in the European Atlantic Area.**

**An open access, visual, dynamic and updatable database to easily identify stakeholders and experts from research centres to commercial chains.**

**Characterize expertise, country and regional distribution of microalgae stakeholders to perform an analytical review of the sector, identify gaps, potential for research, developments, cooperation and opportunities**

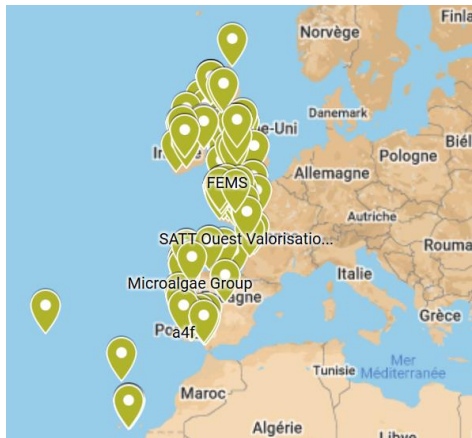

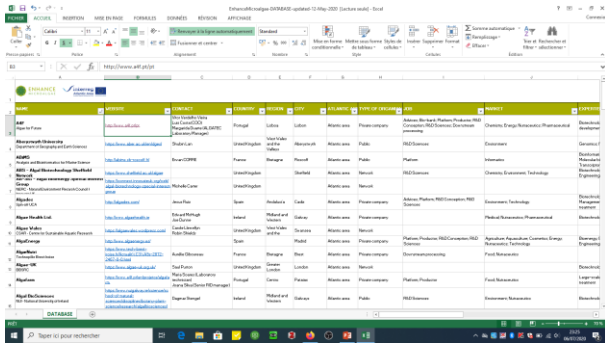


**A collective work: La Rochelle University lead the project and all EMA partners contributed by helping to collect national informations to build the database.**

**2) An updatable excel table with selection drop-down menu to get advanced information on Microalgae stakeholders (189 at the moment)**

**Direct links to websites, mailing address, skills, markets;  
an easy access to target informations by name, national and regional  
localization, sector, activity, type of organization (public/private), expertises,  
and market.**

**The database was used in WP4 to invite key microalgae experts to an EMA  
workshop and contact stakeholders to run a survey and Delphi questionnaires  
to identify scientific/technological/economic/legislative gaps and future  
developments of the sector, leading to 2 papers in Marine Drugs**
